

SCHEDULE OF WELL VISITS also referred to as WELL CHILD VISITS OR PHYSICIANS:

NEWBORN: Patient is evaluated in our office within a day or two of leaving the hospital.

*MANY TIMES WE BRING A NEWBORN IN AGAIN BEFORE THE TWO WEEK PHYSICAL to evaluate weight, etc.

2 WEEK PHYSICAL: Patient is evaluated in our office at two weeks of age.

2 MONTH PHYSICAL: Patient is evaluated in our office at two months of age. At this office visit your child will receive the first of many immunizations administered.

4 MONTH PHYSICAL: The next physical is done at 4 months of age. There has to be at least eight weeks between the 2 month and 4 month visits. Therefore, it is important to schedule before leaving the office.

6 MONTH PHYSICAL: This physical is done at six months of age. There has to be at least eight weeks between the 4 month and 6 month visits. At six months of age, the patient is able to get a flu shot, there is also a flu booster given one month after the initial flu vaccination at any age. For your convenience we schedule flu clinics on weekends, typically in October and November during flu season.

9 MONTH PHYSICAL: Typically the patient does not receive immunizations at this office visit. At this visit we evaluate many appropriate age appropriate milestones.

12 MONTH PHYSICAL: Per school immunization regulations in NYS this appointment can not be scheduled until the patient has turned one year of age.

15 MONTH PHYSICAL: Immunizations are also scheduled at this office visit.

18 MONTH PHYSICAL: Immunizations are also schedule at this office visit.

24 MONTH PHYSICAL: Two year physical, immunizations are not **typically** given at this evaluation.

30 MONTH PHYSICAL: Once again child is evaluated for age appropriate milestones.

3 YEAR PHYSICAL AND YEARLY THEREAFTER: An annual physical is performed. Daycare and preschool/schools require annual physical be performed for admittance/registration. If your child is playing a school sport, an annual physical is also required.
